

OTTAWA PARK GOLF COURSE

DESIGNED BY S. P. JERMAIN - ESTABLISHED IN 1899

Even though the recognized date of 1899 is historical enough for most people, Sylvanus Pierson Jermain, the first President of Inverness Club claimed that golf was actually played on the grounds of Ottawa Park in 1894. Ottawa Park Golf Course has the distinction of being the oldest public course west of New York City.

In 1918, S.P. Jermain was again involved in the growth of golf by guiding the first organized group of women golfers which became the Toledo Women's District Golf Association. The Toledo Golf Club, based in Ottawa, is a charter member of the TWDGA.

In 1922, S.P. Jermain was instrumental in another first for Ottawa, the USGA conducted the first USGA National Public Links Championship at Ottawa Park.

In 1977, many renovations and upgrades to Ottawa's greens, tees, bunkers and irrigation was completed by Toledo's own Arthur Hills. Today, because of those renovations, Ottawa Park is known for fine greens of modern day excellence placed through natural settings that S.P. Jermain said that "nature clearly intended for a golf course."

Please enjoy historical Ottawa Park Golf Course and when you leave the grounds, all of us that love golf, hope that you left this grand old course in better shape than you found it.

USGA RULES GOVERN ALL PLAY EXCEPT AS MODIFIED BY THE FOLLOWING LOCAL RULES

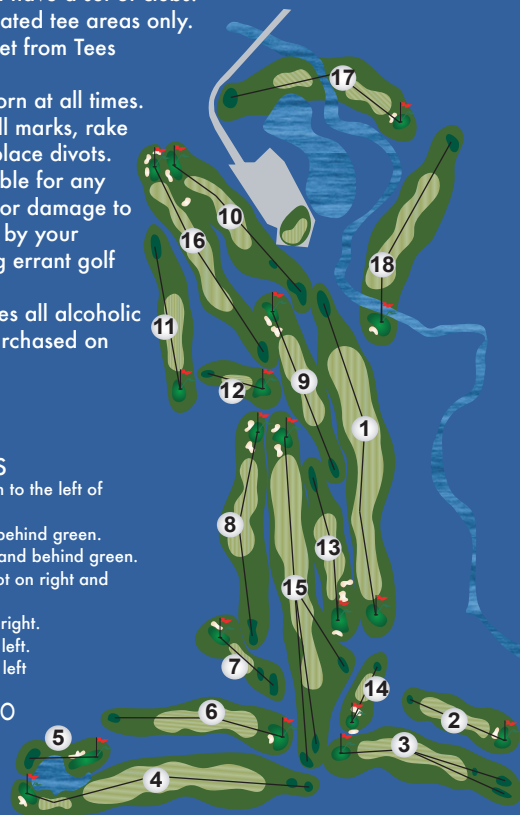
- Every player must purchase, and keep in his possession, a ticket from the golf shop PRIOR to starting play.
- Starting other than on No. 1 Tee requires permission from golf shop personnel.
- Each player must have a set of clubs.
- Play from designated tee areas only.
- Keep carts 30 feet from Tees and Greens.
- Shirts must be worn at all times.
- Please repair ball marks, rake bunkers, and replace divots.
- You are responsible for any injury to people or damage to property caused by your actions, including errant golf shots.
- State Law requires all alcoholic beverages be purchased on the premise.

OUT OF BOUNDS

- The park walking path to the left of #1, #2 and #4 is O.B.
- Hole #2 • OB fence behind green.
- Hole #4 • Fence left and behind green.
- Hole #10 • Parking lot on right and right of the 17th tee.
- Hole #11 • Fence on right.
- Hole #16 • Fence on left.
- Hole # 17 • Road on left

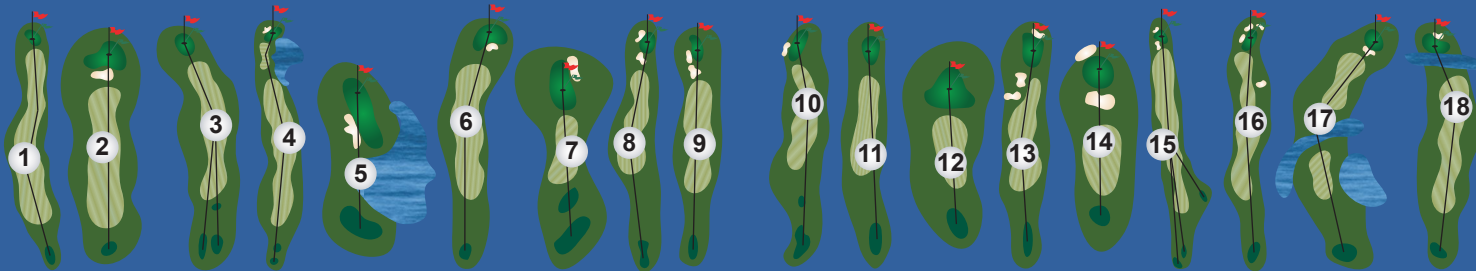
YARDAGE MARKERS TO CENTER OF GREEN
